Each year, students in grades 1 through 12 create an Eden Exposition Project — a student-directed, year-long project that nurtures creativity and hands-on learning. These projects culminate with an opportunity for your child to present their project to parents, peers, and teachers at our Eden Exposition event.

Our active learning approach to all that we do fosters curiosity, creativity, and responsibility in your child, which leads to high achievement in and outside of school. At Mount Zion, your child will realize their creativity and resourcefulness, while learning how to persevere and conquer challenges. Our learning model ensures that your child will be prepared for success now and in what's next in their life.

Raising the Standard on Engaging Hearts & Minds View Overviews of Each School

Primary School

Grades PreK-1

Mount Zion's youngest students explore and discover God's world through hands-on, multisensory learning activities designed to foster each student's individual growth and development. Their school days are centered around intentional routines that foster creativity, problem-solving, and social skills.

Caring teachers and staff provide opportunities for collaborative work and play to encourage students to grow in their independence, responsibility, and perseverance. Focused instruction helps to build a strong foundation in literacy, number sense, fine motor skills, and the expression of ideas through writing. Bible verses, stories, and songs are integrated into each day as children learn about their part in God's story.

Elementary School

Grades 2-4

Your student will have ample chances to make connections, express their ideas, and discover new perspectives as a result of the cooperative learning, group work, and authentic learning opportunities provided. Your child will cultivate critical thinking and develop their love for God and others.

Teachers challenge students to grow in their knowledge of the world God has created while providing real work to meet the real needs of real people. As their understanding of learning continues to grow and they see more of God's story, they begin to see how they are uniquely made to live His story through all that they do, whether that's in the classroom, on the playground, in the lunchroom, or in their communities.

Middle School

Grades 5-8

Our primary goal in middle school is to provide a challenging and encouraging environment that is at all times sensitive to the unique developmental needs of students at this age. We aim to help students move along the continuum toward greater independence, giving them responsibility for their work and behavior. We value the need to take risks and do all work with excellence.

Your student will be eased into the transition to Middle School In a self-contained classroom, where students focus on their core subjects, then they disperse to other classrooms for specials. The Middle School offers plenty of time for community and fellowship, as students attend lunch, recess, chapel, and weekly meetings as a whole group.

Complementing the rigorous set of academic courses, students develop organization and time management skills, cultivate critical thinking skills, and participate in a wide variety of character-shaping extracurricular activities through the arts, sports, student government, and service-learning.

High School

Grades 9-12

Students are well prepared for college and the workforce through our rigorous course of study. Your child will be enriched through engaging in four years of coursework in English & humanities, science, math, and Bible plus three years of a foreign language. We meet your child where they are, and help them to reach their potential by offering classes at both the standard and honors levels. We also offer Advanced Placement Calculus.

If your child plans to attend college, they are able to access dual credits through our partnerships with Colorado Christian University, Dordt University, and New Hampshire Community College System.

Additionally, we offer students opportunities for real-world experience and paid work-study through local businesses. Our on-site internships include Early Childhood Education (ECE) and Spanish internships.

Financial Aid

Discount

Financial Aid

Children's Scholarship Fund and Education Freedom Accounts

Available to Kindergarten through Grade 12 students

Recent laws passed by the NH State Legislature have made way for the CSF scholarship program, designed for families who would like their child(ren) to attend private schools but cannot fully bear the expense. Scholarships can pay up to 75% of the tuition bill! The Children's Scholarship Fund decisions are made by the NH Scholarship Fund.
