Discounts

- A 5% discount is offered to the second child and 10% to each additional child of the same family.
- A 4% discount is offered to families who pay in full on or before May 31st.
- Ask about discounts for qualifying families whose primary income is established in pastoring a church full-time.

External Scholarships

Available to kindergarten through grade 12 students

Recent laws passed by the NH State Legislature have made way for the Children's Scholarship programs, designed for families who would like their child(ren) to attend private schools, but cannot fully bear the expense. Scholarships can pay up to 75% of the tuition bill! The Children's Scholarship Fund decisions are made by the NH Scholarship Fund.

To apply for the **NH Education Tax Credit (ETC) Scholarship**:

1. Go to <https://nh.scholarshipfund.org/apply/nh-education-tax-credit-scholarships/>.
2. Scroll down until you see "How to Apply".
3. Select "New Families".
4. Follow the instructions to submit your application.
5. Apply before June 1st prior to the school year for your best chances of approval.

Families are notified of ETC results by July 31st typically.

To apply for the **NH Education Freedom Accounts (EFA) Scholarship**:

1. Go to <https://nh.scholarshipfund.org/apply/nh-education-freedom-accounts/>.
2. Scroll down until you see "How to Apply".
3. Select "New Families".
4. Follow the instructions to submit your application.

To receive a *100% EFA grant for the 2024-2025 school year*, the application and supporting materials must be **verified by July 15th**. Applications received after July 15th may be eligible for a partial grant.

Internal Scholarships

Available to kindergarten through grade 12 students

Mount Zion offers financial assistance to families who qualify. In order to be eligible for an internal needs-based scholarship, families must first apply for the two external scholarships, even if they do not think they will qualify. There is a \$35 fee to apply for FACTS.

To apply for our **Internal Needs-Based Scholarship**:

1. Go to <https://online.factsmgt.com/SignIn.aspx>.
2. Click "Register".
3. Search for your institution by entering "03103" and selecting Mount Zion.
4. Select "Create a username & password" to begin the application process.
5. Follow the instructions to submit your application and all accompanying documents.
6. Please allow 2-3 weeks for results after your application is verified.

All recipients of the MZ financial assistance program will be required to give 20 hours of community service to Mount Zion Christian Schools.
